



GET YOUR LIBRARY CARD



Reminders:

- Rochester Public Library is a free, public resource for everyone. You do not need to pay anything to borrow books.
- You do not need to be a citizen to get a library card.
- Rochester Public Library will not check your immigration status or share your private information with any other government office.

STEP 1:

Bring a photo ID and proof of residence to the Rochester Public Library at 101 2nd Street SE, Rochester, MN 55904.



STEP 2:

Walk in to the front doors of the library and up to the service desk. Tell the library staff person you would like to get a library card.

Note: Photo IDs can be a passport from any country, a driver's license, or another form of ID. Proof of residence can be a utility bill, a lease, or a letter mailed to yourself.



STEP 3:

Explore the kids' area of the library, where there are children's books to check out and a space to play.
