- -Associate words with pictures and realworld objects so your child will learn the connection of written & spoken language.

MAKE READING A HABIT



- -Read with your child at least once a day at a regularly scheduled time.
- -Reading on a regular basis sends an important message: Reading is meaningful & important!

CELEBRATE THE JOY OF READING!

- -Parents should model the joy of reading so their child can develop a positive relationship with printed words.
- -The goal is for children to grow into adults who read easily and frequently whether for business, knowledge, or pleasure.
